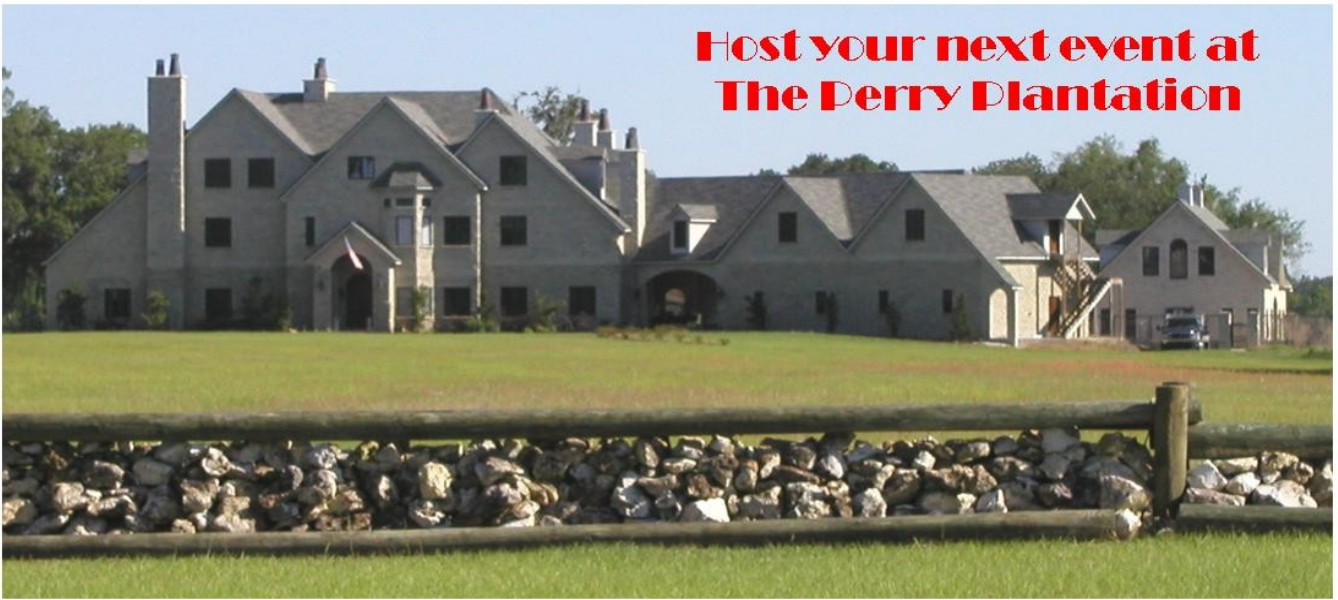


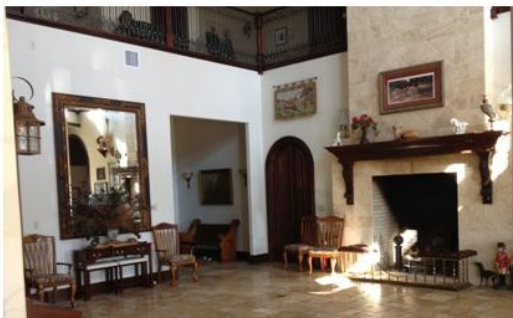
## Host your next event at The Perry Plantation



The Perry Plantation, located in Rochelle (about 8 miles east of Gainesville/ 8 miles north of Micanopy) has hosted many events such as fundraisers, formal balls, political functions, luncheons, weddings, and meetings. The 7500 sq. ft. facility can accommodate approx. 125 people for a sit-down dinner with band and dancing, or up to 300 for a mingling party with or devours. Additional outdoor facilities and various sites around the property may also be used for photo shoots or other aspects of your function. Table and chair rental is available on-site at greatly reduced rates.

The 527 acre historic Perry Plantation is steeped in history. It was the home of the 4th Governor of Florida, Madison Starke Perry, in the mid-1800's. It housed the first civilian fort, Fort Craine, during the Seminole wars, and is now currently a working hay and horse farm, as well as home to the Misty Morning Hounds, a drag-foxfhunting club. The Old English manor house is complete in every detail, including an authentic English pub! Wildlife abounds on the property, and a sunset tour, which can be incorporated into your function, is the perfect opportunity to view large herds of deer, hawks, owls, sandhill cranes, bald eagles, fox, coyote, raccoon, fox squirrel, and even the occasional panther!
